1. Think, write, speak, learn & pursue social, cultural and other interests
2. Engage in free intellectual inquiry
3. Timely use of campus facilities
4. A safe environment conducive to learning
5. Be free from discrimination and harassment
6. Receive feedback on academic performance
7. An environment free from unwanted attention
8. An environment of mutual respect
9. Personal access to individual teaching staff
10. Access to judicial process

Students have the responsibility to...

1. Know campus rules, policies and procedures *{read Student Handbook, listen to Orientation Information sessions - they apply to YOU }*
2. Read course outlines and follow the content *{access Campus Email regularly}*
3. Attend class regularly, prepared and on time
4. Write tests as scheduled: meet deadlines
5. Submit own work *{plagiarism is a serious offense}*
6. Avoid disruptive behaviour that interrupts the learning environment for fellow students
7. Notify instructors of illness or missed classes/tests immediately
8. Seek counsel as a Learning Needs student
9. Meet your co-ordinator/advisor regularly
